TRB continued its strategic expansion in the second quarter through new banking infrastructure and continued investment in priority markets.

In Central Texas, the bank opened its newly constructed Bulverde-Spring Branch banking center, strengthening TRB's presence in one of the Hill Country's fastest-growing corridors. Development also advanced in North Texas, where the Frisco banking center and a new TRB Financial location in Oak Cliff are expected to open in August. Looking ahead, TRB expects to break ground in the third quarter on future locations at the Port of Brownsville in South Texas and Liberty Hill in Central Texas. Collectively, these investments extend the organization's reach while supporting long-term growth in key markets.

TRB supported initiatives focused on historic preservation, regional recovery, and the development of future talent during the second quarter.

In South Texas, the bank sponsored the Fresnel Lens Exhibit at the Historical Museum of South Padre Island, helping preserve an important part of the region's maritime history.
